The Socio-Economic Development of Indian Community Unit (SEDIC) of Prime Minister Department has approved an allocation of RM140,400.00 for the year 2018 to MGC for the purpose of carrying out Tuition classes to prepare students for the UPSR/PT3/SPM Examinations.

This is a pilot project under the Indian Blue Print which is to run for 10 years with the aim, amongst others, to uplift the living standards of the Indian poor by providing them with skills training, tuition classes, etc. With better skills and better results, it is hoped that more Indians will be able to find skilled jobs and with better results more Indians can find places in local universities.

The MGC is initially setting-up tuition centres in Gurdwaras, as follows:

The Gurdwaras in the above states are requested to carry out a survey in their area to see whether there are enough students who are willing to attend tuition classes.

Even, states that are not mentioned in the above list can organise tuition classes in their Gurdwaras and obtain funding from MGC.

Some guidelines for funding are as follows:

- The Gurdwara should carry out survey and identify students.
- Identify subjects to be taught.
- Identify and employ teachers who are competent and excel in their subjects. The success of the programme will depend on the quality of tuition provided. The students after sometime will start dropping out if we cannot provide top-class tuition.
- Teachers can be Sikhs & Non-Sikhs
- Teachers will be paid.
- Payment to tuition teachers: RM50/= to RM70/= per hour. For any higher rate of payment, the request should be submitted to MGC for approval.
- If the total lecture hours run for 4 hours or more, then a tea-break can be made. Up to RM4.00 can be charged per student when applying for fund.
- Strict Accountability: Every payment must be supported by vouchers & receipts.
- Monitoring of progress: Suitable Academicians will be enlisted/appointed to conduct survey on impact and weaknesses. They will also monitor progress of students.
